

## Landowner Opportunities for Permanent Protection


## **RIM Conservation Easements**

Protection efforts are currently underway in central MN with permanent and long-term options for landowners. Have you ever heard of a Reinvest in Minnesota (RIM) Conservation Easement?! RIM Easements mean permanent land protection from housing development or subdivision. These areas are different from public lands in-that they are still privately owned, keeping property on the tax-roll and are meant to maintain forest or grass-land management. Specific waterbodies and watersheds with higher concern for either drinking water or habitat preservation are the target. Current incentives for landowners to participate include a one-time 60% payment of the current county assessed land value. Most easement programs require a minimum enrollment size of 10 acres. Applications are ranked according to habitat values, shoreline length, public land adjacency & other professional criteria.

One of the specific grants available through The Crow Wing & Aitkin Soil & Water Conservation Districts (SWCDs), funded in-kind by The Environmental and Natural Resource Trust Fund, is The Protection of North Central Lakes Grant. This grant focuses on the following Minor Watersheds: Round-Big Pine, Dam-Long, Round, Waukenabo-Round, Spirit-Farm Island, Minnewawa, Cedar, Rat-Flowage, Hill Lake, Camp-Smith, Borden, Ruth, Serpent, North Long-Round, Mitchell, Cullen Chain, and Bay. This project is set to complete approximately 10 permanent conservation easements, 12 forest management plans, and 6 best management practices (on RIM or public lands only).

## 3 Conservation Options Through This Grant:

Crow Wing & aithin Counties





- ✓ SWCD will cover stewardship plan
  - \$200 + \$6.50/acre covered (New & Updating Plans)
- √ Landowner pays to register DNR \$50
- Landowner pays to record SFIA covenant (\$46)

\*In order for us to pay for the stewardship plan, this grant requires you to either enroll into SFIA or a RIM Easement



- √ Cost-share 50% of a project
  - Choose from list of BMPs (Best Management Practice)
  - Permanently protected land only
    - RIM Easement
    - Permanent Protection Program
    - Public Land

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- √ Payment is 60% of the land value
  - Current county EMV
    - (Estimated Market Value)
- $\checkmark$  One-time taxable payment
- √ Retain full ownership (not public)
- √ The land remains on local tax rolls
- √ Legacy protection of land and water
- √ 10+ acres
